The significant addition creates district-wide transportation options. Maple Valley students may travel to RCMS or RCHS and back home to MVE at the end of the day.

Expanding the district-wide routes, however, requires additional drivers. Fortunately, our shuttle busses do not require a CDL endorsement to operate.
