Dear RCS Alumni,

January 2019

The new year marks a special celebration for some and another day for others. Either way, it is a chance to see the King of kings in a new way. Consider Isaiah—struck by a vision of the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted. Six-winged seraphs shook the temple and called to each other, *“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.”*

What was Isaiah’s response? *“Woe to me! I am a man of unclean lips and live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the king, the Lord Almighty.”* Is. 6:5. Accurate glimpses of God reorient us. Similarly, meditating on a passage or prayer can de-abstract scriptural truths. When prayer impacts us, changes our affections, relationships, and commitments, we experience the King of kings in a new way.

Dr. Ole Hallesby, Norwegian theologian, 1879-1961, illustrates the way prayer works from his understanding of mining operations. His description remains one of my favorites. According to Hallesby, demolition to create mine shafts took two basic kinds of actions. The first “which tries everyone’s patience,” is the time when deep holes are being bored with great effort into the hard rock. In contrast, the second action inserted dynamite into a bore hole and then connected it to a fuse. To light the fuse is easy and very interesting. A concussive blast follows, and pieces fly in every direction.

It takes trained workmen to do the boring. Anybody can light a fuse.

Some people prefer “fuse-lighting” prayers. However, the practice is easily abandoned when instant results are not observed. Hole-boring prayers require patience and perseverance. Commenting on Mt. 9: 38, Hallesby adds, “The reason why such a long period of time elapses between Awakenings is simply that the Spirit cannot find believers who are willing to do the heavy part of the mining work.”

I deeply appreciate all who mine in prayer for RCS. An Awakening for Christian education begins with us. Like Isaiah struck with a new vision, the Glory of the Lord must fall anew for RCS to prosper. As a staff, we work, innovate, and improve as if it all depended on us, and pray as if it all depended on God. The call to prayer is for everyone.

Current requests and updates—

- Grow RCS ministry to 440 students this year—*pray for 15 additional students/prospective families.*
- A community grant partner to supplement the Norcliffe Foundation grant application—*continue to pray.*
- Invitation to submit a full grant application to the Murdoch Charitable Trust. Our letter of inquiry sent with a \$658,000 request is now under review.
