

## **Sports Eligibility Requirements for Homeschool Students**

To align with WIAA policy, the following conditions outline how homeschool students can participate with RCS sports teams at the middle school and high school level.

- Homeschool students must be enrolled at least ½ time at a particular campus, through our a combination of traditional classroom and online environments. The ½ time requirement is a WIAA rule to participate in athletics.
- A student enrolled in a <u>traditional classroom setting</u> for ½ time or less is required to pay New Student Registration Fees, Technology Fee, and Facilities Fees.
- Additionally, all district athletic fees apply whether the student is choosing the traditional classroom environment, or combination of online and classroom learning.
- Students are expected to maintain a 3.0 G.P.A while enrolled in RCS coursework, abide by expectations contained in our Parent/Student Handbook, and Athletic Code of Conduct.
