



Sports Eligibility Requirements for Homeschool Students

To align with WIAA policy, the following conditions outline how homeschool student can participate with RCS sports teams at the middle school and high school level.

- Homeschool students must enroll at least $\frac{1}{2}$ time at a particular campus, through our online programs, or a combination of traditional classroom and online environments. The $\frac{1}{2}$ time requirement is non-negotiable to participate in athletics.
- Families choosing to satisfy the WIAA requirement entirely through online courses will register as a Returning Student and pay $\frac{1}{2}$ of RCS registration fees. The facilities fee is waived.
- A student enrolled in a traditional classroom setting for $\frac{1}{2}$ time or less pay $\frac{1}{2}$ of all New Student fees. Students enrolled for more than $\frac{1}{2}$ time in a traditional classroom setting pay all New Student fees.
- Additionally, all district athletic fees apply whether the student is choosing the online route, traditional classroom environment, or combination of online and classroom learning.
- Students are expected to maintain a 3.0 G.P.A while enrolled in RCS coursework, abide by expectations contained in our Parent/Student Handbook, and Athletic Code of Conduct.
