An internship opens the door to working in an employment sector aligned to God's gifting and calling. There are many benefits including developing a professional network within the industry/sector, adding valuable references for future employment, potential scholarships, and career opportunities that may include landing a permanent job at the internship site.

It is important to remember, that the internship site and the site supervisor connect to a network across the employer's clients, colleagues, and industry/sector contacts. Keep that in mind. How you perform during the internship will be shared by the site supervisor across their networks.

During the internship, students remain ambassadors for the Lord and for Rainier Christian Schools. An intern's conduct, language, and employability skills are expected to align with RCS' vision statement focused on excellence. A successful internship earns 0.5 credits on the transcript. 180 hours are needed to earn the one-half credit. Much of that occurs over the summer.
